ABIDE Prayer Guide

Invited to Rest

"Come to me, all of you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke and learn from me, because I am lowly and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light." (Matthew 11:28-30)

Jesus tells us to come to Him. We are invited into a relationship with Jesus and we are not asked to do anything or change anything before we respond to His invitation. Jesus welcomes us into His presence regardless of how we feel or the burdens of pain or sin that we are carrying. Jesus welcomes us and promises that He will give us "rest." We can stop striving and depend on His grace, His power, His provision for our lives.

Opening Prayer

As we begin ABIDE, take a moment to quiet our hearts and minds – to be still before God.

Let's ask God to help us receive His rest as we surrender our hurdens and striving to Him

You may want to pray a "breath prayer" as you inhale and exhale, such as, "Jesus, I rest in you".

Prayer: Father, we love you and we need you. Holy Spirit, fill us and lead us as we gather to pray and study Scripture. We dedicate this time to you and what you have for us to receive from you as your sons and daughters. Remove any distractions and help us to focus our hearts on you. In Jesus Name, Amen.
