THE DEADLY EXCHANGE

The Battle of Independence

Independence

freedom from the control, influence, support; selfdetermination; the ability to live your life without being helped or influenced by other people.

Independence is healthy and a normal path in human development.

Independence is important to be successful in life.

However, independence from God is a trap and hinders us from walking in freedom!

HELP ME OR I GOT THIS

"He also told this parable to some who trusted in themselves that they were righteous and looked down on everyone else: "Two men went up to the temple to pray, one a Pharisee and the other a tax collector. The Pharisee was standing and praying like this about himself: 'God, I thank you that I'm not like other people- greedy, unrighteous, adulterers, or even like the tax collector. I fast twice a week; I give a tenth of everything I get.'

"But the tax collector, standing far off, would not even raise his eyes to heaven but kept striking his chest and saying, 'God, have mercy on me, a sinner!' I tell you, this one went down to his house justified rather than the other; because everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, but the one who humbles himself will be exalted" (Luke 18:9-14)

What is the answer to Independence from God?



After he said good-bye to them, he went to the mountain to pray. Well into the night, the boat was in the middle of the sea, and he was alone on the land (Mark 6:46-47)

Devote yourselves to prayer; stay alert in it with thanksgiving (Colossians 4:2)

Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God, so that he may exalt you at the proper time, casting all your cares on him, because he cares about you (1 Peter 5:6-7)

The LORD is near all who call out to him, all who call out to him with integrity (Psalm 145:18)

FREEDOM IS DEPENDENT ON PRAYER

PRAYER LEADS TO FREEDOM

THERE IS NO FREEDOM APART FROM PRAYER!

PRAYER IS CONNECTING OUR HEART WITH GOD.

CONNECTED TO GOD?

COMMON LIES ABOUT PRAYER

- God doesn't really listen to my prayers
- I don't know how to pray
- My prayers aren't really powerful and effective
- Praying is actually boring
- I don't have the spiritual gift of prayer
- Prayer doesn't really make a difference
- I will never be good enough to pray
- My prayers are weak
- I have too many sins to pray

FREE TO PRAY

Ask God to reveal to you every lie the enemy tells you about prayer.

Ask God to forgive you for believing the lies and to break the "agreement" you've made with those lies.

Ask God to help you believe what He says about prayer and to give you a passion for prayer.

Prayer is about our Relationship with God

Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens - Jesus the Son of God - let us hold fast to our confession. For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who has been tempted in every way as we are, yet without sin. Therefore, let us approach the throne of grace with boldness, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in time of need (Hebrews 4:14-16)

You will call to me and come to me, and I will listen to you. You will seek me and find me when you search for me with all your heart (Jeremiah 29:12-13)
