Adopt the same attitude as that of Christ Jesus, who, existing in the form of God, did not consider equality with God as something to be exploited. *Instead he emptied himself* by assuming the form of a servant, taking on the likeness of humanity. And when he had come as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death even to death on a cross. For this reason God highly exalted him and gave him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee will bowin heaven and on earth and under the earth and every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Prayers - Thanking Jesus for the Gift of Prayer

Scripture tells us, "Therefore, let us approach the throne of grace with boldness, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in time of need" (Hebrews 4:16). Because Jesus



came to earth and gave His life for us, we can enter the throne room of heaven with boldness through prayer.

Prayers - Sharing the Gift of Prayer

We can even be intentional this Christmas Season, and set aside extra time each day to give others the gift of prayer. The Spirit may even lead us to write a note, send a text or call someone and pray for them.

Let's pray and ask Jesus to help us share the gift of prayer this Christmas Season. And let's ask the Spirit to speak to us and lead us to pray.

Prayer:

Jesus, help us share the gift of prayer this Christmas Season. Holy Spirit, speak to our hearts, help us hear you and lead us as we seek to share the gift of prayer with others.

Closing Prayer: Jesus, thank you for coming for us. Thank you for taking on our sin, darkness and shame so that we could be in a relationship with you.
