Resetting our Hearts on God

Prayer is the means in which we "reset" our hearts on God and His Kingdom. And as we set our hearts on God and His Kingdom, the Spirit works within us to lead us to pray. Today's ABIDE contains 3 basic steps that can help us "reset" our hearts on God and His Kingdom. The steps are: 1) Humbling ourselves before God and telling him we need him, 2) Exalting God above all things, 3) Praying for others and for His glory.

"For this reason I kneel before the Father from who every family in heaven and on earth is named." (Ephesians 3:14)

Let's begin ABIDE with a posture of either physically kneeling (if you are able) or with your hands open as a way of humbling ourselves before God and confessing our dependence on Him.

- Take a moment to silently pray and tell your Father that you need him.
- After a moment of praying silently, pray an opening prayer such as, "God, I/we worship you and adore you. Thank you that you are here with me/us. Spirit fill me/us and lead this time of prayer."
