Candy Cane

1 Timothy 1:5

This candy cane is shaped like a “J” to remind us of Jesus. The white stripe reminds us that Jesus was pure and sinless. The red stripe helps us remember that Jesus shed his blood for our sins.



Sheep Sticker

Sheep follow their shepherd's voice. Jesus loves us and wants us to follow him. He watches over us, cares for us, and keeps us from harm. We are his sheep and He is our shepherd. Always ask, "What did Jesus say?"

Talk about the Lord's washing His disciples' feet. The disciples were to serve others. How can each of us be a servant to others?






Angel Ornament

Ephesians 5:2




Picture of Friend

Our world is full of people who need a neighbor! Dear Jesus, you have taught us to love our neighbor. Help us to be a good neighbor to everyone.






Play dough

for my life.



The wise Men brought treasures with them to give to Jesus. We can give our own gifts to the Lord by obeying His word and by doing kind deeds for others.






Sealed Candies

2 Corinthians 1:21-22


These candies are sealed inside
