### Learn together!

Learning the books of the Bible can be fun for the whole family. Here are a few memorization activities to play when the summer rays are too hot to be outside!

#### Personalize Bible flashcards.

The simplest way to make Bible flashcards is to use index cards, but you can use any materials around the house.

Encourage your kids to say the Bible books aloud as they write the title. For example, this project could be broken down into the division of the Books of the Bible groups. Then, they can have fun making a connection that helps them remember!

*Pro tip*

#### A Little of This and That. Make a circular map.

Write the books of the Bible in a circular shape by division.

This is a great time to use color. Your child can pick the color pattern for each division. Be sure to encourage questions while they are creating the artwork.

*Pro tip*

As the family drives around town on errands, take turns calling out division by color from their artwork they see.

#### It is Show Time!

Help your child make a rhyme or song from the books of the Bible.

*Pro tip*

Our brains have an easier time remembering patterns and music, so using your child's favorite song and singing the books of the Bible will be fun and help recall.
