# How to Grow in Your Relationship with God

Preschool Bible Study Activity

## WATCH:

After the show finishes, share with your child, "As we watched three young owls discover what it takes to grow seeds (water, sun and soil), we also learned what it takes to grow in our relationship with God (prayer, reading scripture and fellowship with others)."

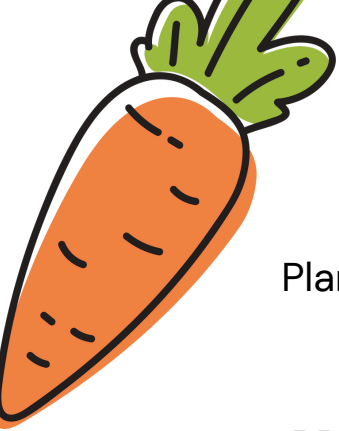
## LEARN TOGETHER:

What is Prayer? Talking to God about everything and giving him praise!

What is reading Scripture? Scripture is God's Word. We call it the Bible. In it, he tells us of his faithfulness!

What is fellowship with others? Community helps and serves each other.





### PLANT A SEED:

Plant a seed in your yard or in a pot together. As you plant, pray, read and discuss:

**PRAY** with your child asking God to grow them toward his purpose for their life.

**READ** Matthew 13:23 with your child and talk about some of the “fruits” you see God growing in their life.

**DISCUSS** how your child has opportunities to create new friendships with others in their neighborhood, school, church, or extracurriculars. Talk about what fellowship with others looks like for your family.

### NOW, PLAY!

Play a game with your child! Call out example behaviors that may or may not help them grow in their relationship with God. Kids start off in a ball like a seed. As you call out behaviors, have them either stand tall like a tree if it would help them grow (i.e., praying for friends, learning a memory verse, talking about God’s word with friends) or wilt like a thirsty plant if it wouldn’t help them grow (i.e., lying, disobeying parents, choosing not to pray).
