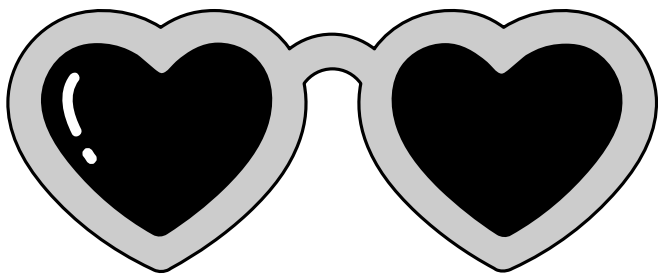
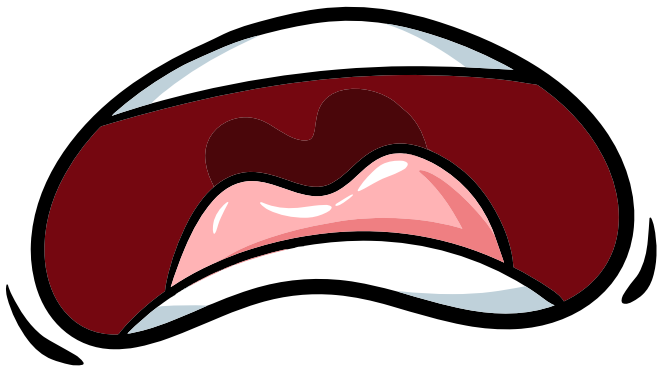
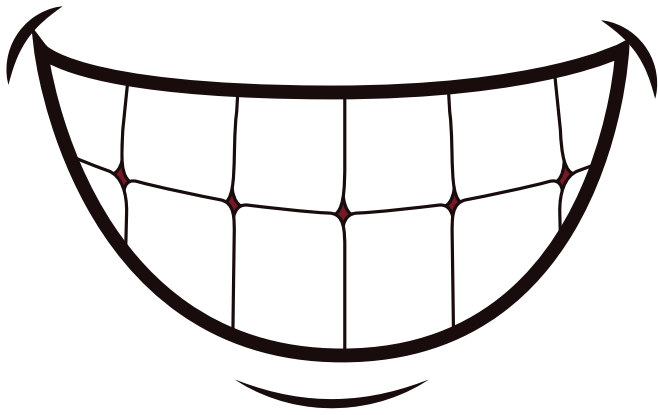




How does your pumpkin feel?
